

regard to **need** for I have **learned** in whatever state I am to be **content** I know how to be abased and I know how to abound everywhere and in all things I have learned both to be full and to be hungry both to abound and to suffer need I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me nevertheless you have done well that you shared in me distress now you Philippians know also that in the beginning of the gospel when I departed from Macedonia no Church shared with me concerning giving and receiving but you only for even in Thessalonica you sent aid once and again for my necessities not that I seek the gift but I seek the fruit that abounds to your account indeed I have all and abound I am full having received from Epaphroditus the things which was sent from you a sweet smelling aroma an acceptable sacrifice well pleasing to God and my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

6. By their **practice** of the **principle** of **Giving** and **receiving** the Philippians **proved** in concrete terms the true sharing of life, based on **common union** with Christ and partnership with **One Another**.



- 1. **Discourse Analysis**: What did Jesus speak about again and again?
 - Out of his 38 parables 12 dealt exclusively with money while most of the others were money related. One out of every six verses in Mathew, Mark and Luke touches the subject of money and more than 20% of everything Jesus said in scripture has to do with our actions and attitudes towards mammon.
- 2. The **semantics** of Biblical **"fellowship":** Tsumeth, Chabar, metoche and **koinonia**.

The link between spirituality and finances is illustrated by the use of the word "Koinonia" a word meaning fellowship, partnership, intercourse, distribution, communion, communication, partaker, companion, associate and sharer but mostly in the context of sharing money.
